LOCATION:

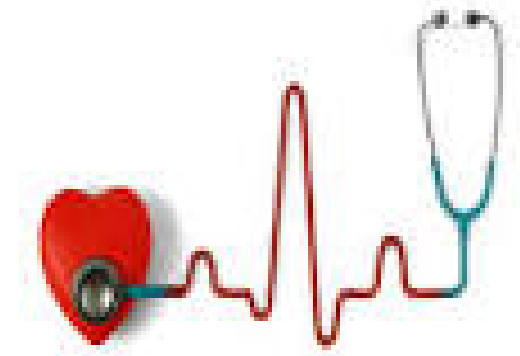
The Education & Development Classrooms are located in UH Tower, second floor, adjacent to elevators. A map can be provided with the confirmation notice.

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HEARTCODE ACLS

HeartCode ACLS is an official, self-directed, comprehensive eLearning program from the American Heart Association (AHA). HeartCode ACLS Part 1 uses eSimulation technology to present realistic patient scenarios. Students are presented with a team dynamics lesson, 10 ACLS hospital-based case scenarios, and a written exam. While interacting with the program, students assess each patient, formulate a treatment plan based on ACLS guidelines, and provide treatment.

Successful completion of Part 1, the cognitive component, and Parts 2 and 3, skills practice and testing with an AHA ACLS Instructor meets the requirements for obtaining an AHA ACLS Provider course completion card.

COURSE MATERIALS:

Part 1: E-learning program available on line

The ACLS manual can be referenced as part of the E-learning program. Some students find it helpful to have a hardcopy manual.

Please note:

QMC offers the Heartcode course option ONLY to students who are recertifying. We recommend that students taking ACLS for the first time enroll in an Instructor-Led Training/classroom based course.
